Consider the Child's Point of View

Re-read Scenario #2 Finding Another Way, about the father, a taxi driver, who is trying to enroll his child in a state funded Pre-K program. Put yourself in the child's place. Imagine how she might experience the outcome of an administrator's actions, if after an enticing visit to preschool with her family, she learns that she can't attend because of her father's job.
