ACTIVITY 4

Building Grippers



INTENT:

Practice adapting a tool with a gripper.

OUTCOME:

Participants interact while creating an adaptation for a musical instrument.

MATERIALS REQUIRED:



- Variety of grippers (curling foam, playdoh, thread spool)
- Handout 8: Tots 'n Tech Grippers
- Handout 9: Adapting Musical Activities for Persons with Disabilities



TIME: 10 minutes

PROCESS:

- 1. Participants find Handout 8: Tots 'n Tech Grippers.
- 2. Participants choose the rhythm sticks they will use for the rest of the training.
- 3. Highlight the importance of reflecting on curriculum and adapting for all individual needs to enable access.
- 4. Optional: Participants read Handout 9: Adapting Musical Activities for Persons with Disabilities.
- 5. Say to participants, "Before we use these rhythm sticks to practice patterning as a group, let's adapt several so that we can practice implementing the adoptions and feel the differences."
- 6. Have at least two people at each table group choose a different way to build a gripper. Follow the instructions on the handout and complete the adaptation of the rhythm stick.
- 7. When the adaptation is complete, participants will move on to using the rhythm sticks.

DEBRIEF: What other items can you think of to add grippers to in your classroom?



SUMMARY:

Participants practice building and using adapted materials.
