Course Title: Preschool English Learners

Description:

This one-day training course concentrates on the *Preschool English Learners Resource Guide* (PEL Guide) developed by the California Department of Education, Child Development Division. This training is offered for teachers in state-funded and other childcare programs. One unit of academic credit will be offered to students based on their attendance in class and the successful completion of assignments. Students must also sign in and out to verify their attendance at the training. To receive credit, students must register using the attached CSUCI registration form and mail it to the address on the form.

- 2. Complete a written assignment two pages in length.

Implement at least two strategies that are discussed in the PEL Guide. It is expected that students will use the knowledge gained in the class along with their readings to implement strategies, gather evidence of how they worked and write up their successes and challenges. Students will write at least a two-page paper describing how they implemented these strategies into their classroom/program and discuss the successes and challenges. Students will also discuss in the paper, which strategies they will continue to use, and new strategies to try.

The assignment is graded based upon the understanding of the content of the PEL Guide, not on child outcomes. It is expected that students will use the knowledge received during the one-day training in addition to information read in the guide to complete the written assignment.
